Dear Friends of Bolinas Lagoon:

I am writing to announce a revision to the Open Space District's release and public response schedule for the Philip Williams Associates' draft report regarding the evolution of Bolinas Lagoon. Rather than distributing and posting the report during the week of November 14, 2005 as I had recently announced, that will now take place on January 2, 2006. A 30 day Public Comment period will commence at that time.

The District is making this schedule change for two reasons. Attendees at the public meeting on November 7<sup>th</sup> felt that the holidays would impede their ability to adequately comment within the 30 day review period. Also, the additional time allows for a more scientifically comprehensive draft report because comments from peer review committees and new sedimentation data will have been considered.

In March, 2006, the draft Final report including response to comments will be presented at a public meeting. Subsequently, the Bolinas Technical Advisory Committee will consider the report before the Open Space District Board of Directors' take action on accepting the report. Following Board action, the Executive Committee of the County / Army Corps of Engineers partnership will meet to consider options related to completion of the Feasibility phase.
